The City will continue to receive comments and feedback from the public and another report to Council will come forward in late spring/early summer to discuss the possible amendment again.

Emphasis continues on public education to keep educating the public that feeding wildlife is prohibited within City limits, and doing so is in contravention of by-law number 139-2008.
