Funding Agreement - Court Security Prisoner Transport

4. Moved by R. Lunny, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

That Council give three readings to a by-law to authorize the execution of a three year agreement between Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services and the City of Kenora for funding in the total amount of \$138,175.94 under the Court Security Prisoner Transportation Program.

Endorsation of Resolution – Pave Highway Shoulders

5. Moved by R. McMillan, Seconded by R. Lunny & Carried:-

That the Council of the City of Kenora hereby receives the December 16, 2011 resolution from the Township of Carling with respect to supporting and endorsing a Private Members Bill to pave highway shoulders; and

That if the Bill is passed it would require a minimum one metre paved shoulder on certain provincially owned highways to improve public safety for cyclists, pedestrians and motorists alike; and

That studies in other jurisdictions confirm that where paved shoulders exist, accidents are drastically reduced; and

That there is obvious health benefits for individuals and society in general as more opportunities are provided to cycle and walk for recreation or for transportation;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of the City of Kenora supports MPP Norm Miller's Private Members Bill to pave highway shoulders; and further

That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Honourable Bob Chiarelli, Minister of Transportation of Ontario, Sarah Campbell, Kenora-Rainy River MPP, and the Township of Carling.

Surplus Lands - Sale to Swejda

6. Moved by L. Roussin, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

That the City of Kenora herby declares surplus, lands described as part of Block E, Plan M423, designated as Part 2, 23R12037; and

That the City of Kenora transfers the lands to Victoria Swejda, to be consolidated with lands described as Lot 58, Plan M423; and

That Victoria Swejda is responsible for all costs associated with this transfer; those of surveying, the cost of the property for a price of \$449.31 (32.62m \times 4.57m =149.07 square metres converted to square feet =1604.67 \times \$0.28) and all transfer/legal costs; and further

That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to enter into the agreement of purchase and sale.

Surplus Lands - Hydro Easement

7. Moved by L. Roussin, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

That the City of Kenora hereby declares surplus, lands described as Part 1 on Plan 23R 12037, as an easement in favour of Kenora Hydro; and further

That these lands form part of the agreement authorized by By-law Number 140-2011.

Zoning By-law Amendment (Deon)

8. Moved by L. Roussin, Seconded by R. McMillan & Carried:-

That Council hereby approves Zoning By-law Amendment Z03/11 (Deon) for the purpose of amending the property from RR – Rural Residential to HC – Highway Commercial [21] to permit contractor service as a light industrial use; to permit the residential use to continue; and to bring the property into compliance with Zoning By-law Number 160-2010 as amended at property described as 1B Matheson Bay Road, CON 1J PT LOT 14 EB1628 PCL;20681 and 1A Matheson Bay Road CON 1J PT LOT 14 LOC KM196 DES RP KR1543 PART 1 PCL 27161 as the continued use of the property for light industrial, commercial and residential purposes is consistent with the Provincial Policy Statement (2005) and meets the purpose and intent of both the City of Kenora Official Plan (2010) and Zoning By-law Number 160-2010 as amended for the reasons outlined in the planning report.
