Recommendation:

That the following quotations, for the Kenora Receation Centre Boat Launch Washrooms, (HST extra), be received ; and further,

Hy-Grade Precast	\$38,225.00
Parkworks	\$48,500.00

That the City of Kenora accepts the quotation submitted from Hy-Grade Precast Concrete to supply and deliver a precast washroom facility (Benchmark Plus) for the amount of \$38,225.00 plus HST.

Background:

With the City of Kenora's endeavour to be a premier boating destination there is currently a lack of available public washrooms adjacent to our city's docking and launching facilities. It has been identified that a washroom facility at the rear of the Kenora Recreation Centre (boat Launch) would provide much need facilites for the boating public and Recreation Centre users (skatepark, basketball courts, walkers, and during special events).

The building selection was developed from a review of the current public washroom facility inventory, and will be similar to buildings the MTO have purchased for roadside washrooms in 2011. The review indicated that concrete precast buildings have provided a much higher level of sustainability and longevity in public spaces, as evident from the current condition of the existing washrooms located at Beaty,Central parks and provincial roadside stops. From the information gathered, the facilities supervisor has devopled the quotation document relating to the specifications and for qualified suppliers for the project.

The following two quotes were received (not includeing HST) : Hy-Grade Precast \$38,225.00

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Parkworks	\$48,500.00

Additional funds for completetion of this project will include, engineering, site preparation, plumbing and electrical works.
