### **Recommendation:**

**Whereas** the City of Kenora accepted the proposal of KGS. to provide consulting services for the Replacement of the Eighth Avenue South Pumping Station;

**Now Therefore** the Council of The Corporation of the City of Kenora enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Mayor and Clerk of The Corporation of the City of Kenora are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement between The Corporation of the City of Kenora and KGS Group., in accordance with the terms and conditions therein and affix the Seal of the Corporation thereto.
2. THAT this by-law shall come into force and be in effect from and after the final passing thereof.

The City put out a Request for Proposals for the planning, design and construction administration and inspection for the Replacement of the 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue South Pumping Station. KGS was awarded the project and a purchase order was issued to them as their price was the lowest and was within the signing authority of administration staff.
