#### Information on Voting by Mayor and Council under The Municipal Act, 2001

243. Except as otherwise provided, every member of a council shall have one vote;

- 245. Any question on which there is a tie vote shall be deemed to be lost, except where otherwise provided by any Act;
- 246. (1) If a member present at a meeting at the time of a vote requests immediately before or after the taking of the vote that the vote be recorded, each member present, except a member who is disqualified from voting by any Act, shall announce his or her vote openly and the clerk shall record each vote;
- (2) A failure to vote under subsection (1) by a member who is present at the meeting at the time of the vote and who is qualified to vote shall be **deemed to be a negative vote**.
