Information on Voting by Mayor & Council under The Municipal Act, 2001

243. Except as otherwise provided, every member of a council shall have one vote;245. Any question on which there is a tie vote shall be deemed to be lost, except where otherwise provided by any Act;

246. (1) If a member present at a meeting at the time of a vote requests immediately before or after the taking of the vote that the vote be recorded, each member present, except a member who is disqualified from voting by any Act, shall announce his or her vote openly and the clerk shall record each vote;

(2) A **failure to vote** under subsection (1) by a member who is present at the meeting at the time of the vote and who is qualified to vote shall be **deemed to be a negative vote**.

Background:

Tenders for the Cameron Bay Sewer and Water project closed on Tuesday, September 1, 2015, with three companies submitting the following tender pricing: (plus HST):

Moncrief Construction Ltd.	\$ 994,138.00
Titan Contractors (Kenora) Ltd.	\$1,348,993.00
Makkinga Contracting and Equipment Rentals	\$3,674,961.00

This project is a City sewer and water extension to service Tall Pines Marina located on the east side of Cameron Bay and to also extend sewer and water mains to the west side of Cameron Bay for future development. The City and Tall Pines have agreed to the installation of services for the marina development and required easements to accommodate City owned mains to cross the Marina property.

KGS, the engineering consulting firm for the project, has done an evaluation of the tenders received and recommend that the project be awarded to Moncrief Construction. Attached is the KGS report for your reference.
