• **Communities in Bloom Update (Barb Manson)**

Barb Manson advised she had attended the Nationals in Brandon and met with over 600 delegates. City of Kenora won 5 Bloom and 2nd place Status. First place winner was Parksville with 10,500 population and a much larger staff than Kenora has.
