TRADE IN W20 CASE & 544 JD

- Council approved the release of tender for the purchase of 2
   Front End Loader low hour units under Resolution No. 16.
- Buying 2 machines allowed higher cost saving
- The units were tendered by invitation to all major equipment dealers and posted on the City and local tender websites.
- Trade-in units were also advertised for outright sale to the public.

- Lowest bid, submitted by Toromont Cat, was rejected due to

not meeting the minimum specifications, listed in tender.
