#### DEPUTATION – Bart Stebnitsky - Swail between Lots 6 & 7 38 Shauna Crescent 12:20 TO 12:35 Mr. Stebnitsky wishes to develop Lot 7 at 38 Shauna Crescent, but is requesting the City address the ditch hazard that separates Lots 6 and 7 as part of due diligence. The Subdivision development did not include defined ditch allowances. An on-site visit determined the alleged hazard to be more of an eyesore then a liability issue. City to consider earmarking works as part of Capital Plan to be completed in phases with Phase 1 to start in 2005. Project will require a C of A, surveys and easement agreements.
